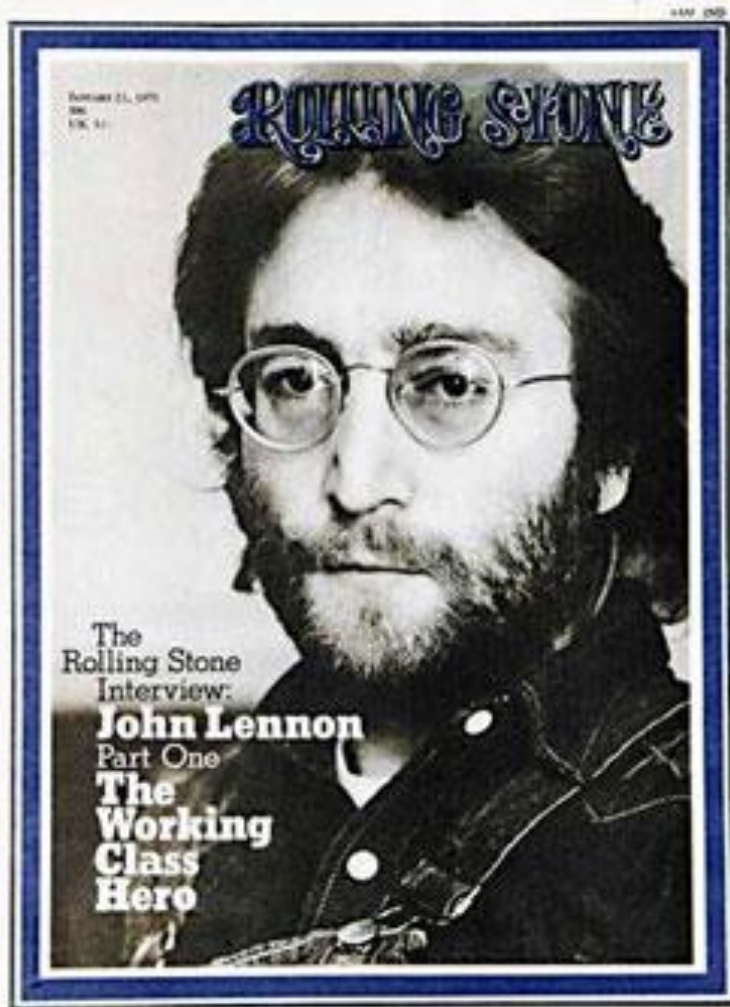
# Early Life

- In 1970, *Rolling Stone* hired her. Her first assignment was to shoot John Lennon for the cover.
- She eventually became *RS's* chief photographer.

# Career

- In 1983, she joined *Vanity Fair*. She became known for her unusual celebrity portraits.

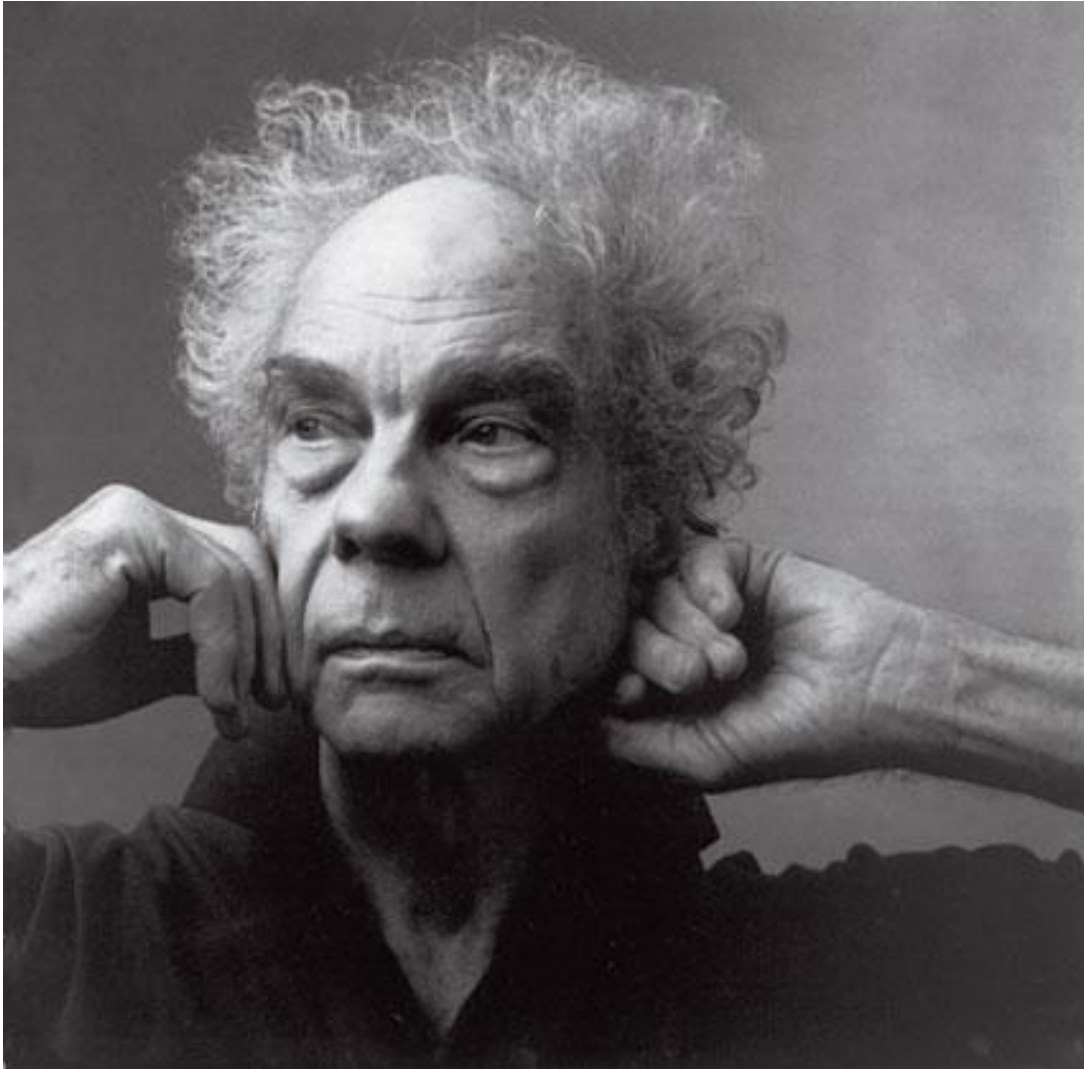




# Value
