COMPLETED (5 POINTS EACH)	Use the internet to find a minimum of 3 animated characters. Each character must be from different animations. All characters you select must be facing the same direction. Example: If the body is turned left while the head is turned right, the pieces may fit together awkwardly.						
	1. Animated Character #1 is included in Animation Composite.						
	2. Animated Character #2 is included in Animation Composite.						
	3. Animated Character #3 is included in Animation Composite.						
COMPLETED (25 POINTS EACH)	Use the following tools to mesh the 3 characters into 1 correctly proportion character: MAGIC WAND, QUICK SELECTION, CROP, ERASER, MOVE, RESIZE & ROTATE						
	4. Animated Character #1 has been composited proportionately with other images.						
	5. Animated Character #2 has been composited proportionately with other images.						
	6. Animated Character #3 has been composited proportionately with other images.						
COMPLETED (5 POINTS)	Place the animation composite character in an animated background that is unrelated to the 3 animated characters used for the composite. Do not include random characters who may be hanging out in the background.
