<b>COMPLETED</b> (10 POINTS EACH)	Use the <b>Fill</b> tool to add the <b>primary colors</b> (yellow, red & blue) to the Pop Art Color Sheet. Each color must be used a minimum of <b>8+ times</b> . Place primary colors in a <b>variety</b> of places throughout the Pop Art Color Sheet.

<b>COMPLETED</b> (10 POINTS EACH)	Use the <b>Fill</b> tool to add the <b>primary dot patterns</b> (yellow, red & blue) to the Pop Art Color Sheet. Each pattern must be used a minimum of <b>8+ times</b> . Place primary patterns in a <b>variety</b> of places throughout the Pop Art Color Sheet.
